SESSION 4: Part 1: The Sea of Galilee - A Virtual Tour and Discussion of its Continued Importance as a Freshwater Resources

This session will cover the challenges facing the Sea of Galilee (Lake Kinneret) Watershed and its multiple users. The Sea of Galilee is the largest freshwater lake in the Middle East and is suffering from low inflows due to drought and upstream water utilization.

SESSION 4: Part 2: Documentary Film - "Beyond the Mirage"

The screening of the film will be followed by discussion of the parallels between the wicked water problems of this Middle East region and the Colorado River Basin, which supplies water to approximately 40 million people in the Western United States. As time permits, participants will engage in open dialogue of Wicked Water Problems generally. Parts of the documentary were filmed in Israel in October 2015.
